



Curriculum

At **3:17 Hybrid of Blythewood**, our curriculum for the Sandy Level (two-day program), is chosen with great care and aligns with our **Philosophy of Education**. We value hands-on learning, rich discussion, and meaningful engagement. All subjects are taught from a **biblical worldview**, with teachers weaving Scripture, character, and godly wisdom into daily lessons.

Our goal is to spark curiosity, encourage thinking, and help students love learning.

History

Grades 1–6: *Story of the World*

Grades 7–8: *Mystery of History*

We use a narrative approach to history that allows students to see God’s hand across time. These programs help students make connections across cultures, events, and ideas, building a strong historical foundation.

Composition

Grades 3–8: *Institute for Excellence in Writing (IEW)*

Students begin formal composition training in **third grade**. IEW gives students step-by-step writing tools they can use in every subject. As they learn structure and style, they grow in confidence and clarity.

Science

Grades K–8: *Curriculum TBD*

We are currently evaluating science programs that best support discovery-based, hands-on learning. The curriculum we choose will integrate observation, exploration, and critical thinking—taught through a biblical lens.

Literature

Our literature selections correspond with the historical time period students study in *Story of the World* or *Mystery of History*. Reading books connected to their history unit deepens understanding and enriches discussion. Students experience stories that strengthen vocabulary, imagination, and empathy.
