Grade Levels Offered

K4–8th Grade

- K4 & K5 combined ○ K4 students must be 4 by June 1 ○ K5 students must be 5 by September 1
- Grades 1–8 taught in individual grade-level classes

At-Home Learning & Homework

As a hybrid program, most instruction takes place during on-campus days, with additional learning completed at home on non-campus days. Homework is designed to continue instruction and complete curriculum—not simply extra practice.

Homework expectations increase with grade level:

- PreK–Grade 1-2: Minimal at-home work (reading, Show-and-Tell preparation)
- Grades 3–4: Light to moderate assignments, including reading and writing
- Grades 5–8: Regular at-home work in most subjects to support academic growth and preparation for high school

Because classroom time is limited to 2 days per week, regular completion of at-home assignments is required in grades 5-8. Completed homework allows students to arrive prepared to participate fully in class, as well as ensures students complete curriculum requirements. While parents are the primary educators, excusing your student from homework should be the exception. Consistent completion of homework is expected for all students at 3:17.

*Expect classwork and homework to grow steadily more demanding with each grade level, with the biggest jumps typically occurring at the 5th, 7th, and 9th grade transitions.
